Free Zone Aruba (FZA) is a corporation owned by the Aruban Government. Our objectives are to promote the Aruban Free Zone, as well as manage and develop the free zone properties and facilities.

Our three main goals:

Attract solid international investments

By means of a concession we issue the admission license and administrate the operating requirements. Our 'one-stop shop' model facilitates and accelerates the establishment of a client's company in the Free Zone.

Develop and manage attractive Free Zone facilities

We are constantly improving our services and facilities. With the development of the new Free

Zone in Barcadera we offer a unique hub with the harbor and airport. This hub facilitates the smooth flow of goods and services.

Promote a high class and world renowned free zone

Our regulations promote international business, the reputation of the Free Zone and our clients. The integrity system we developed and use meets the highest international standards and recommendations.

Business Opportunities

Almost all types of business activities are eligible for the free zone status, such as: international trade, industry and technology, global services or a combination.

International trade

Traditional trade in finished goods has been the most well-known type of free zone business.

The safety and security of the Free Zone of Aruba is of particular advantage for international trade activities.



Industry and Technology

The Free Zones of Aruba offers excellent locations for the establishment of industrial and (green) technology based activities.

Industry and technology companies operating in the Free Zone do not incur import duties on packaging- and raw materials, semi-manufactured products and components used in the production process. In some cases, construction materials may be brought in duty free.

Global Services

The Aruba Free Zone is an excellent facility to provide services to the global market. The modern free zone concept and multilingual Aruban population offers unique opportunities for different types of service companies to use Aruba as hub.

Different types of services geared towards foreign clients are possible in the Free Zone. Contact us for allowed service activities.

Facilities

We offer warehousing and office spaces for rent at very competitive prices and possibilities to construct your own facilities at the Barcadera Free Zone.

Government

If our clients need advice in dealing with Customs, requesting longlease land, etc. we are happy to assist. Our extensive network of contacts is available for our clients and our account executives are always at your service.

Maintenance and security

We do our utmost to maintain and improve our facilities and provide a safe, secure and accessible business environment.

Client area

We have developed an online client area for companies operating in the Free Zone. On this platform we share news, articles, business opportunities, etc.

Costs and Fees

All services provided by Free Zone Aruba (FZA) in relation to the admission procedure are free of charge. However, there are a few operational costs and fees.

Startup costs

The startup costs are mainly notary charges. These are paid directly to the notary to incorporate a corporation NV) or limited liability company (VBA). The current notary fees are about Afl. 3000,- (+/-US\$1700,-).

Freezone Facility Charge

Once a free zone company is admitted to the Free Zone it is required to pay a Freezone Facility Charge (FFC). The FFC is currently set at 1% of the net turnover and will be charged on a monthly basis, figured over the previous month.

We use the FFC to cover the costs of various facilities and investments, such as security, maintenance, marketing, promotion and further development of the Free Zone.

Office spaces and warehouses

The monthly rental prices of the office spaces range from US \$ 250 to US \$ 750 the average monthly rental price for warehouses is about US \$ 1350.



Locations and Facilities

The Aruba Free Zone currently consists of two designated areas in Bushiri and Barcadera. We offer warehouses for rent or access to long-lease land to construct your own facility at the new Barcadera Free Zone.

Bushiri Free Zone

The distance between the Bushiri Free Zone and downtown Oranjestad is approximately 2 km (1 mile); the distance to the international airport is approximately 5 km (3 miles).

Warehouses

The standard warehouses are on average 300 square meters (3,200 square feet). The floor to ceiling height is 5.5 meters (18 feet) measured from the lowest point and 7.5 meters (24 feet) measured from the highest point.

The units are suitable for goods storage or for industrial activities and can be rented on a yearly basis. All units have standard utilities such as electricity, water and toilet facilities.

Office spaces

The office spaces at Bushiri Free Zone are different sizes and convenient for all types of service-oriented business activities. The units may also serve as a showroom space. The office spaces are ready-to-use facilities, with: air conditioning, carpeting, blinds, standard telephone/ fax/small network lines, alarm monitoring access doors and a intercom system.

Barcadera Free Zone

This property is an ideal showcase location. The new Barcadera Free Zone is located in a growing industrial area, adjacent to the new cargo port at Barcadera and approximately 3 km (2 miles) east of the international airport.

Lease land for construction

At Barcadera Free Zone there are ready-to-build sites available for business activities that require custom-made buildings. The Barcadera area is roughly divided into three sections: Industrial and Technology zone, International Trade zone and Global Services zone.

Acquiring the right of long-lease land for the construction of buildings at Barcadera Free Zone goes through the Department of Infrastructure and Planning (DIP).

Setting up a Company

Do you see potential in the business opportunities offered by the Free Zone of Aruba? We offer a one-stop shop approach to have your business up and running as soon as possible. Our team is ready to help you and guide you through the admission process, making it easy and efficient.

After contacting us, you will be referred to an account executive who will assist, guide and support you through the various procedures. To initiate the admission procedure, your account executive will make a preliminary assessment of the proposed type of business activities and how your requirements can best be met. The admission procedure is as follows:

1. Contact Free Zone Aruba (FZA)

We will review with you if your business fits the free zone concept and how we can meet your needs for particular facilities (such as location, public utilities and operational support).

2. Sign pre-admission agreement

If you decide to go ahead with the application, a pre-admission agreement will be signed. This document regulates the information necessary to complete the admission process.

3. Submit business information

A business plan and personal data are needed to assess the establishment of your free zone company. It is required to have substantial e conomic activity on Aruba.

4. Formal admission

When the legal documents have been submit-

ted, reviewed and incorporated by notary, your free zone company is formally admitted to the Free Zone by means of an admissions license and contract.

Local representation

In case the managing director is a non-resident, a local representative needs to be appointed.

Intermediary services

We work closely with different government departments, notaries, banks and legal, tax and financial advisors.
